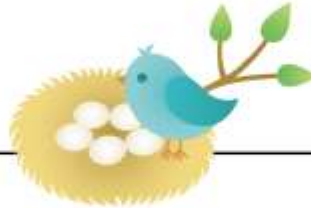

All classes are Bible-based and reinforce memorizing the Westminster Shorter Catechism in Modern English.

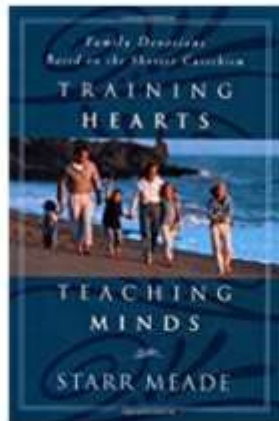


LET THE CHILDREN COME

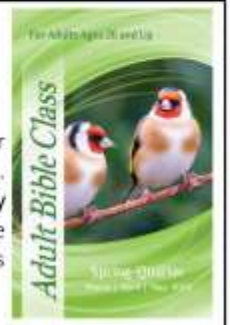
ADULT Sunday School - Spring Term

The Book of Job — Room 121

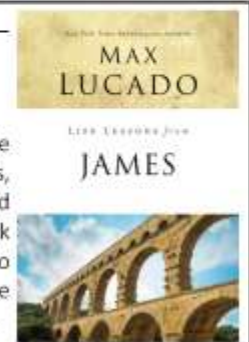
Video & discussion with Craig Lahtinen
