



# ADULT Sunday School - Spring Term




The Book of Job — Room 121 Video & discussion with Craig Lahtinen

#### Adult Nursery Volunteers Needed!

In order to staff the nursery appropriately, we need adult volunteers to step up and help Megan Michael as she cares for the little ones. Megan loves her work in the nursery! She has all her clearances, lots of experience, and does a great job, but in today's culture we really should have 2 people on staff in the nursery each week.

What makes it easy:

- Megan knows the ropes and the regulars very well and has been handling nursery by herself for a while, so being a "helper" should be pretty light work.
- There's already a good support system in place to pull in other help if needed people are monitoring the situation from inside the sanctuary, and more help is available at the flick of a switch.
- You don't have to miss out on the service! The service is displayed on a TV in the nursery.
- You don't need to be the only helper! Bring along a friend with clearances, or a
  younger person who is old enough to be really helpful but who isn't old enough
  to take a turn by themselves.
- Having solid coverage in the nursery can help Megan get a break sometimes to be in the service.
- If tiny ones that are extra special to you will be in town for a week, you can easily schedule that as a week you can help.
- · The more people help, the smaller the job is for everyone!

What is needed:

- We need adults and older young folks who are willing to help, even a little bit every once in a while is great!
- · If you can't be on the floor playing with babies, can you hold a baby while sitting?
- If you can't change a diaper we can still use your help!
- If you don't have your clearances to work with children, or haven't updated in a while, you may need to apply. We plan to have a lunch one Sunday for volunteers, and we will help people to get or renew their clearances right then!
