This will be our 9th Annual Mt. Pleasant Church Women's Retreat. Those that have attended in the past have enjoyed fellowship and time spent with other women who share in the love of Christ.

Our speaker this year is Terry Musser, sister of Denise Lander. After graduating high school, she enrolled in the College of Agriculture at Penn State with aspirations to become an Extension Agent, specifically working with a 4-H program. These programs were hard to come by after graduation, so Terry took a position as a high school vocational agriculture teacher for two years and then decided to return to Penn State for her Master's degree in Agricultural Education. She eventually landed an Extension Agent position with a 4-H program in Lawrence County, PA. After moving to Centre County, Terry found a position with Penn State in the College of Agriculture, working as an academic adviser for students. It turned out to be her dream job, working with students helping them navigate the University. It was the most rewarding job she could ever have dreamed of. Terry completed her Master's degree in 2006 and finished her PhD in Instruction Systems. After 35+ years working at Penn State, she retired in 2020. In 2015, Terry felt called to participate in a program of the Presbytery to certify lay preachers to fill pulpits within the Presbytery. She began preaching in 2016 and continues that ministry today, filling pulpits in churches around the Presbytery. She also serves on their Committee on Ministry.
