MT. PLEASANT CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

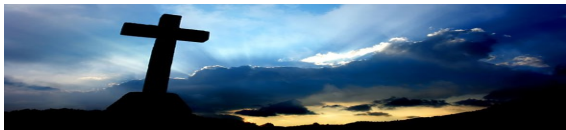
