WSC Q. 53. Which is the third commandment?

A. The third commandment is, Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain: for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

If we were making our own list of the ten most important moral imperatives for human flourishing, how many of us would include a commandment like this?
