Catechism Corner

WSC Q. 69. What is forbidden in the sixth commandment?

A. The sixth commandment forbiddeth the taking away of our own life, or the life of our neighbor, unjustly, or whatsoever tendeth thereunto.

We are not to take the life of our neighbor or our own life. There are, of course, exceptions to this (as the "unjustly" indicates). It is permissible to defend oneself in war or in selfdefense, for instance. But the principle remains the same: we must not kill. But we must also protect against "whatsoever tendeth thereunto." The Law includes a command that calls for a fence around an open rooftop, and repercussions if failing to do so leads to injury or death for your neighbor. We must protect life as well as not actively taking it.
