

### Catechism Corner

#### WSC Q. 71. What is required in the seventh commandment?

*A. The seventh commandment requireth the preservation of our own and our neighbor's chastity, in heart, speech, and behavior.*

The seventh commandment forbids “adultery.” But this carries with it the call to several important positive actions. It requires that we act to preserve – that is protect, keep – chastity. Not only should we not engage in this sin ourselves, but we must seek to love our neighbors by positively acting to help them preserve their marital health, or their chastity in singleness. In our own marriage, we must not simply drift along, but positively act – engage in “preventive care” to make sure we maintain marital health. To fail to do so is a violation of the seventh commandment.
