Catechism Corner

WSC Q. 73. Which is the eighth commandment?

A. The eighth commandment is, Thou shalt not steal.

We usually think we're on safe ground here as long as we don't rob banks, pick pockets, pilfer other people's stuff, etc. But the principle is much larger than this, as the catechism will go on to make clear. Stated positively, God doesn't just care about saving our souls for heaven, he cares also about the stuff of the earth – property, possessions, and so on – our own and other people's stuff. And if he cares, so should we.
