Catechism Corner

WSC Q. 75. What is forbidden in the eighth commandment?

A. The eighth commandment forbiddeth whatsoever doth, or may, unjustly hinder our own, or our neighbor's, wealth or outward estate.

The eighth commandment forbids us to "steal." But that involves more than just not actively engaging in open theft. We are responsible to do what is necessary to protect the property of others as well. If someone dumps trash on our neighbor's property, that's our concern. If someone vandalizes a town park, that's our concern. If a politician mishandles public resources, that is a moral matter for us.
