# **Catechism Corner**

## WSC Q. 76. Which is the ninth commandment?

A. The ninth commandment is, Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.

The ninth commandment on a surface reading seems to forbid giving false testimony in court – perjury. But the principle God would teach us through the commandment is much, much broader than that! God requires us to be people of truth. People in whom there is no deceit. People to whom, as Jesus will say, "Yes is yes; No, no."
