Catechism Corner

WSC Q. 96. What is the Lord's Supper?

A. The Lord's Supper is a sacrament, wherein, by giving and receiving bread and wine, according to Christ's appointment, his death is showed forth; and the worthy receivers are, not after a corporal and carnal manner, but by faith, made partakers of his body and blood, with all his benefits, to their spiritual nourishment, and growth in grace.

We eat outward signs: bread and wine. But the sign points to an inward work. Spiritually our souls are nourished as we feed on the truth of Christ's death for our sins on the cross. We are nourished in soul by faith and strengthened for the continued service of our Lord. Christ isn't bodily present in the elements, but he is spiritually present. He feeds us in our souls.
