Catechism Corner

WSC Q. 97. What is required for the worthy receiving of the Lord's Supper?

A. It is required of them that would worthily partake of the Lord's Supper, that they examine themselves of their knowledge to discern the Lord's body, of their faith to feed upon him, of their repentance, love, and new obedience; lest, coming unworthily, they eat and drink judgment to themselves.

Those who partake of the Lord's Supper should do so worthily. This means we should examine ourselves – take a hard look at the condition of our souls. We should confess our sins. We should reflect on Christ's sacrifice for our sins. We should reaffirm our faith in him and allow the gospel truth to shine anew on our souls. To do less is to partake unworthily.
