Sabbatical Corner

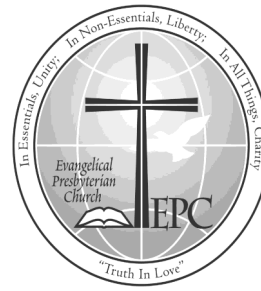

Catechism Corner

WSC Q. 99. What rule hath God given for our direction in prayer?

A. The whole Word of God is of use to direct us in prayer; but the special rule of direction is that form of prayer which Christ taught his disciples, commonly called the Lord's Prayer.

The Lord's Prayer is a model prayer. Jesus gave it to us not so that we would mindlessly repeat it, but so that we would be able to follow the example of the pattern he laid down. We should pray in the manner Jesus teaches us in the Lord's Prayer. If you ever wonder what kinds of things you should pray for, spend some time considering the Lord's Prayer.
