Catechism Corner

WSC Q. 100. What doth the preface of the Lord's Prayer teach us?

A. The preface of the Lord's Prayer, which is, Our Father which art in heaven, teacheth us to draw near to God with all holy reverence and confidence, as children to a father, able and ready to help us; and that we should pray with and for others.

We are taught to address God as “Our Father, which art in heaven.” Both elements of that address are important. God is our Father, which is a picture of incredible intimacy with our God. We’ve been adopted into the family of God through faith in Christ. What a picture of closeness and relationship to Christ. But God is also “in heaven.” That reminds us that though he’s our Father, he is also God. We should hold him in reverence and awe. We should hold him in awe and treat him, his law, his Word, his commands with respect.
