## Catechism Corner

### WSC Q. 101. What do we pray for in the first petition?

*A. In the first petition, which is, Hallowed be thy name, we pray that God would enable us, and others, to glorify him in all that whereby he maketh himself known; and that he would dispose all things to his own glory.*

The first things that Christ teaches us to ask God for is to let his name be “hallowed.” This is archaic language for “being made holy.” Our first desire in seeking God is for him to be honored and revered. We want above all things for God’s name to be honored and praised by all men under heaven.
