#### WSC Q. 104. What do we pray for in the fourth petition?

A. In the fourth petition, which is, Give us this day our daily bread, we pray that of God's free gift we may receive a competent portion of the good things of this life, and enjoy his blessing with them.

We are taught to pray not for everything we may want or desire, but rather to seek from God what is necessary for us (and necessary for us today). Many of us spend so much time and energy worrying about what may come in a month, year, or decade. But Jesus says we should rather focus on the needs of today. This prevents us from being anxious. It also curtails greed. It likewise deepens faith as we see God's daily faithfulness and respond to it with thanksgiving.
