**WSC Q. 47. What is forbidden in the first commandment?**

*A. The first commandment forbiddeth the denying, or not worshipping and glorifying, the true God as God, and our God; and the giving of that worship and glory to any other, which is due to him alone.*

One of the ways to violate the first commandment is through unbelief. It is, in fact, a very great sin not to believe in God. It is likewise a sin to say we believe in God, but not to give him his due – to neglect worship, or prayer, or submitting to his Word. It is likewise a sin to say we worship and serve the one true God, while simultaneously devoting ourselves in heart and mind to the service of some lesser god.
