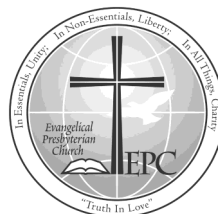

WSC Q. 54. What is required in the third commandment?

A. The third commandment requireth the holy and reverend use of God's names, titles, attributes, ordinances, Word, and works.

Most people assume that the third commandment only pertains to certain formulae of swear words. It is certainly possible (and common) to blaspheme God in speech, taking his name "in vain." But it means a lot more than this. We are required by the third commandment to honor God's "names, titles, attributes, ordinances, Word, and works." Take ordinances – if God says to do something and we don't do it, we despise his ordinance and thereby take his name "in vain." If we neglect Scripture, we despise God's Word and thereby take his name "in vain." This may be the most commonly violated commandment, even for those who don't "swear"!
