CATECHISM CORNER

WSC Q. 57. Which is the fourth commandment?

A. The fourth commandment is, Remember the sabbath day to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labor, and do all thy work: but the seventh day is the sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

The fourth commandment hallows the seventh day (Saturday for the Jews), as a day of worship and service to the Lord. It is to be a time free from normal work, a day of rest and worship. God knows better than we do what is good for us. Many of us are prone to constant busy-ness. We need rest, though. We were made for it. And we neglect it to our own peril.
