CATECHISM CORNER

WSC Q. 60. How is the sabbath to be sanctified?

A. The sabbath is to be sanctified by a holy resting all that day, even from such worldly employments and recreations as are lawful on other days; and spending the whole time in the public and private exercises of God's worship, except so much as is to be taken up in the works of necessity and mercy.

Most people today seem to think of worship as something that is nice to do, if it is meaningful for you, and if you don't have other more pressing things to do. It is sort of an optional. Nice but not necessary. This isn't God's view. He lays down the fourth commandment to make it clear that his expectation is that we dedicate one day in seven to his worship and praise. It isn't so much about us and what we think we need, or about whether we "get anything out of it." It is about him and his glory; it is for his service and honor unto the Lord. The Sabbath command remains in effect, but Christ's resurrection transforms it (as Christ transforms all Creation).
