CATECHISM CORNER

WSC Q. 62. What are the reasons annexed to the fourth commandment?

A. The reasons annexed to the fourth commandment are, God's allowing us six days of the week for our own employments, his challenging a special propriety in the seventh, his own example, and his blessing the sabbath day.

The point here is that the Sabbath commandment is based on the created order. God has woven into the Creation itself the rhvthm of work, rest, and worship. We neglect it to our own diminishment. Ignoring Sabbath will not aid us our souls, our minds, our work. We will not achieve greater prosperity (in any meaningful sense) by doing so. We honor God, and we swim with the current of Creation, when we submit ourselves joyfully to the keeping of Sabbath.
