Catechism Corner

WSC Q. 64. What is required in the fifth commandment?

A. The fifth commandment requireth the preserving the honor, and performing the duties, belonging to everyone in their several places and relations, as superiors, inferiors, or equals.

The commandment to honor father and mother includes the idea of obedience, "performing the duties" appropriate to a child, but it also includes the notion of "preserving the honor." This means not only obedience, but obedience *with respect*. The attitude (as expressed in body language, tone, facial expression, promptness, etc.) is just as important as the obedience itself. What is more, the commandment does not only relate to the relationship between parents and children, but implies the principle of respect and performance of duty "to everyone in their several places...." In other words, this principle is relevant to employers and employees, to students and teachers, to governors and the governed, and so on.
