Catechism Corner

WSC Q. 78. What is forbidden in the ninth commandment?

A. The ninth commandment forbiddeth whatsoever is prejudicial to truth, or injurious to our own, or our neighbor's, good name.

The ninth commandment forbids us to bear false witness. One of many applications to this is that we are forbidden speaking what is "injurious to…our neighbor's good name." This is tremendous moment for all of us in view of the temptation to gossip. It is very common to hear a juicy bit about another. It is always tempting to join in such conversation, throwing whatever fuel we can on the fire, or, at least, listening interestedly to whatever scoop others have. But we are to protect our neighbor's good name. This means we should be fire fighters, not fire feeders. Our default position should be to squelch the rumor mill, not to crank it up.
