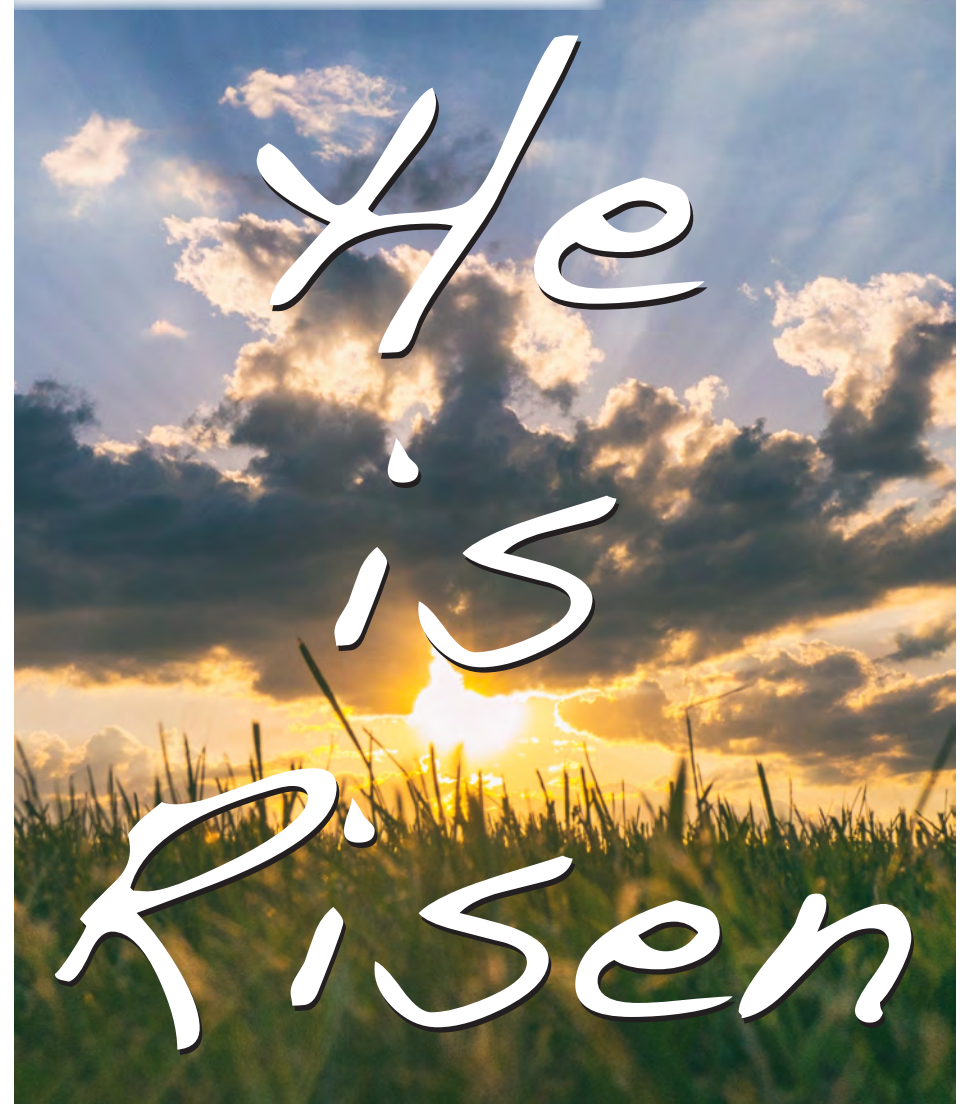

**Catechism Corner**

**WSC Q. 81. What is forbidden in the tenth commandment?**

*A. The tenth commandment forbiddeth all discontentment with our own estate, envying or grieving at the good of our neighbor, and all inordinate motions and affections to anything that is his.*

The tenth commandment forbids us to “covet.” One of the things that leads us to covet is the ugly sin of “envy.” Sometimes we covet because we want what other people have for ourselves. But sometimes we just can’t stand to see other people succeed! We don’t so much want what they have, but we want them not to be so successful. Some people don’t struggle with this, but many do. God would have us rejoice with those who rejoice, however. We should delight in our neighbor’s good fortune, and act to increase that rather than resent it.
