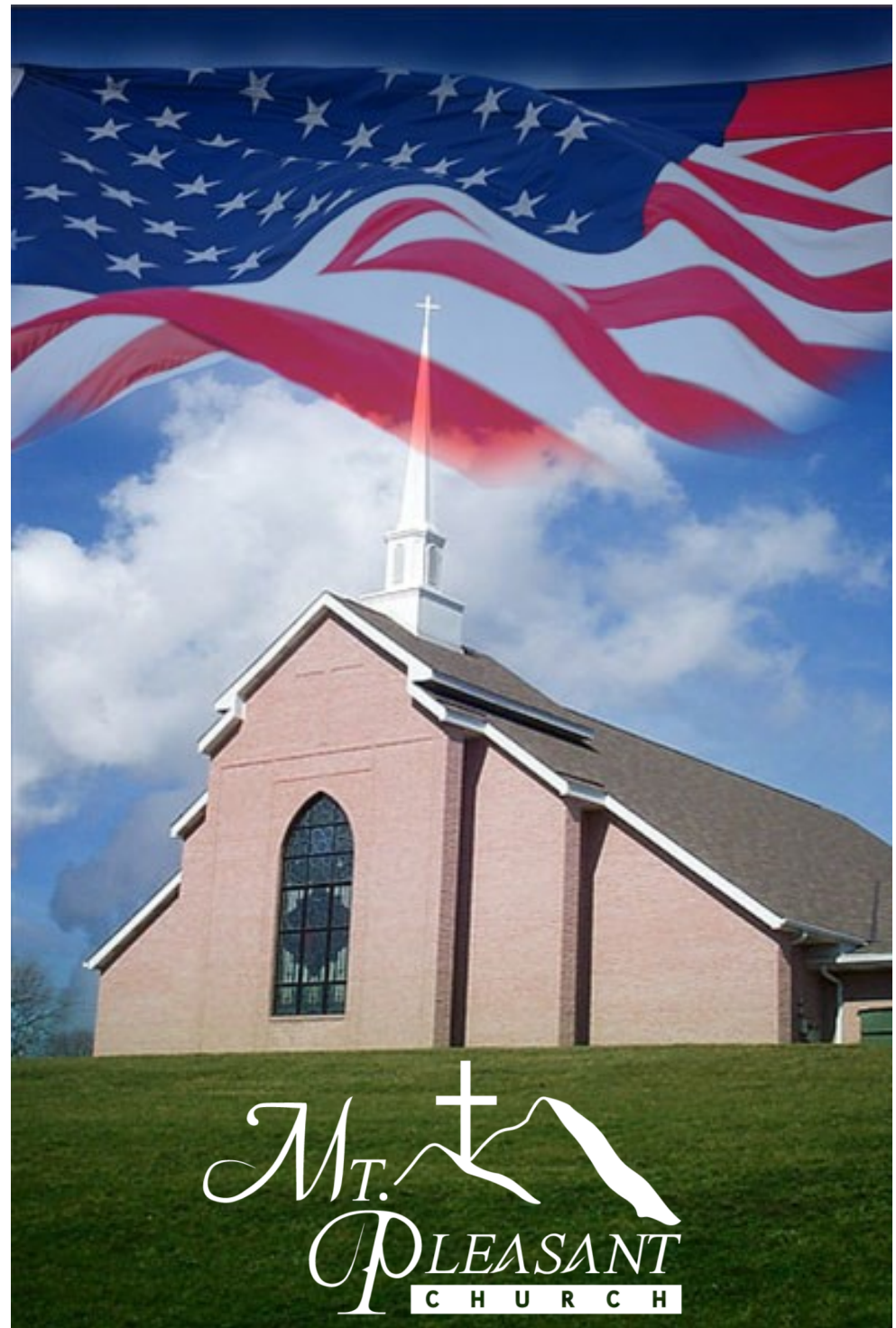

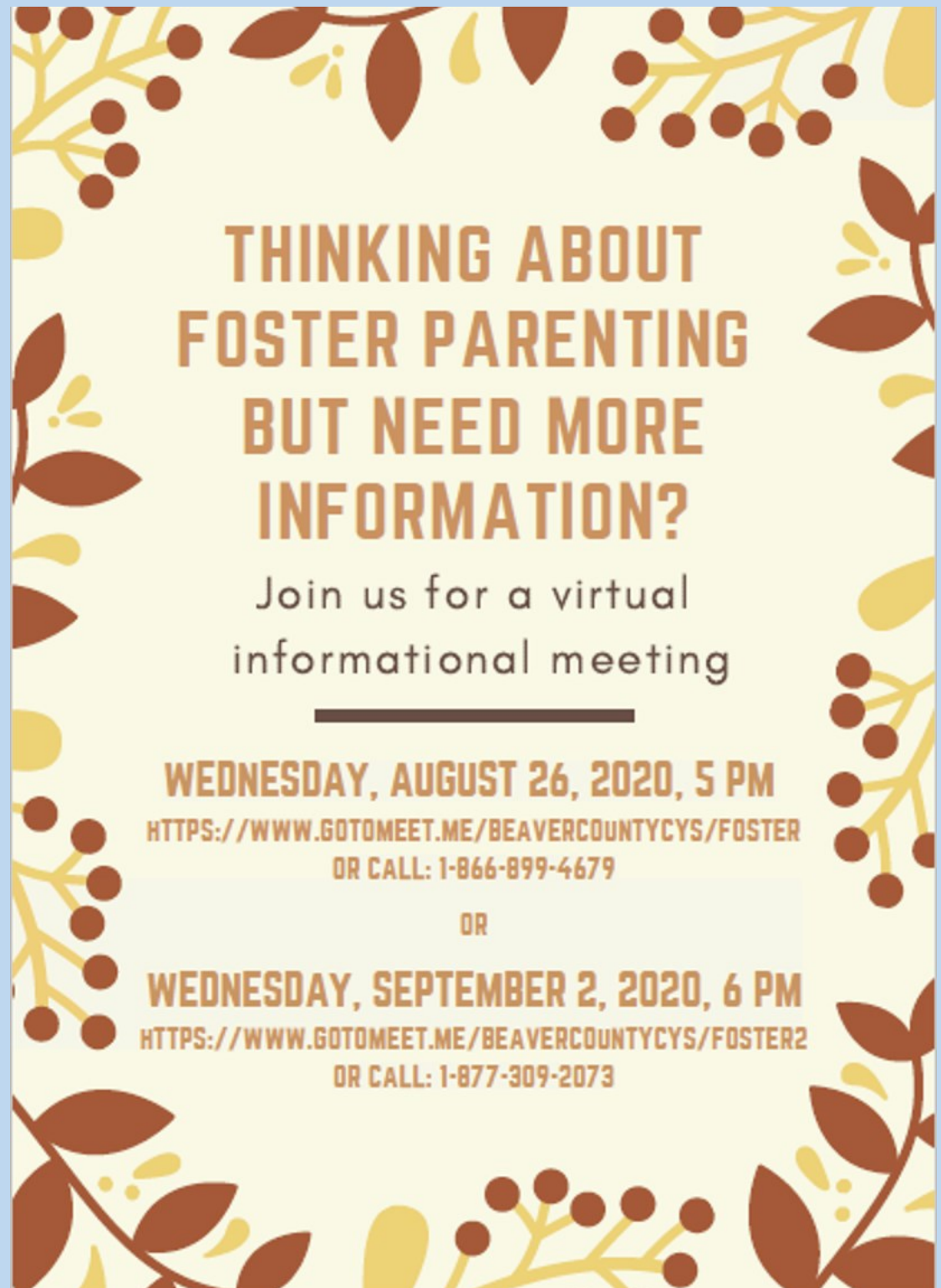
Hello!
