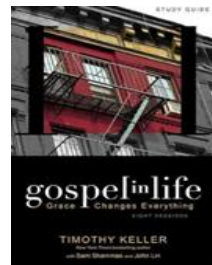

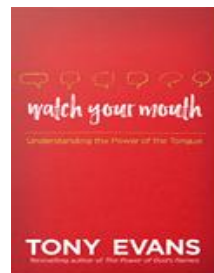


Watch Your Mouth by Tony Evans
